Inauguration of Diglipur Branch Extension Counter



Diglipur, June 22, 2012: The Extension Counter of the Diglipur branch has been inaugurated by Shri.S.Athirstavel, G.M, NABARD, Regional Office Port Blair on 22.06.2012 at 9:30 a.m which was a long felt need of the Diglipur branch as well as customers of the branch. Shri.S.Athirstavel. GM in his Key note address given the details of various schemes available from the NABARD which are being implemented by the ANSCB like KCC, GCC, SCC, SHGs and JLG's.

Shri. Ravinder Rao, Managing Director while addressing the gathering told that there won't be any hurdle for purveying the banks credit to its customers in future. In order to boost up the business of the bank , various actions/ steps were initiated by the Managing Committee of the Bank to revive the PACS, taking the bank



into CBS by 31st March 2013 with the facilitation of NABARD, Installation of ATM's , construction of branch buildings etc.

During the programme, the branch has disbursed 52 No. Of KCC Cards to farmer members of six affiliated PACS of the Bank involving a sum of ₹ 75.00 lakhs by the hands of Chairman, and G.M, NABARD.
